These skills are required to live an independent and meaningful life, yet many people living with developmental disabilities often require support from others to do these skills. This training is designed to teach strategies and tools to improve independence in these areas, which will ultimately lead to a better quality of life for our clients and their families.

"ABA: Autism and Beyond " – Applied Behaviour Analysis (ABA) is widely recognized as a very safe and effective treatment for autism. It is being endorsed, and even required, by several federal and state agencies in many countries as a necessary service for those living with Autism. It is often less known how the principles of ABA are utilized in a wide variety of areas including performance in the workplace, the penal system, with animals, in business, to address social issues and within many other every day arenas. We encourage you to attend this training to learn about this very effective approach, and the many other areas beyond autism that ABA is used.

"Skill Generalization: What Does This Really Mean?" – Do these scenarios sound familiar to you: A child behaves one way with one parent, but a different way with another? They use their language with adults but not peers. Their alphabet seems strong at school but not at home. Why does this happen? Transferring and continuing skill use across all environments, people and scenarios both accurately and fluently is the hallmark of true mastery of a skill. This training will address these issues, and provide concrete strategies and tactics to help ensure that the skills we teach produce generalized outcomes.
